In document ST 7695/25 ADD 1, in the ANNEX:

- At page 9, Section B, point c should read as follows:
- c. The standards set out in this **agreement** are without prejudice to national legislation related to the tasks that have to be performed by licensed and trained, in-house or external, security staff. All security staff shall also have received adequate training when national legislation so requires.

– At page 17, Section C, (ii), point 2 should read as follows:

2. Three months before the end of validity of the certificate, operators wishing to renew the certification shall request that the certification body of their choice re-audits the safe and secure parking areas. The re-certification audit shall be organised and the results transmitted to the parking operator before the expiry date of the current certificate.
