Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Council Directive 92/43/EEC as regards the protection status of the wolf (Canis lupus) (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 7 March 2025, the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 192(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 30 April 2025².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
- 4. On 8 May 2025, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal³. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the agreement reached between the institutions on taking over the Commission proposal and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in <u>PE-CONS 8/25</u>, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Belgium</u>, <u>Spain</u> and <u>Poland</u> abstaining.
- 6. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
