Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund to provide assistance to Austria, Poland, Czechia, Slovakia and Moldova relating to floods occurred in September 2024 and Bosnia and Herzegovina relating to floods occurred in October 2024 Approval

1. On 27 May 2025, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the EU Solidarity Fund (EUSF), accompanied by proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 10/2025¹.

2. The purpose of this proposal is to mobilise the EUSF for a total amount of EUR 270.07 million in commitment and payment appropriations, of which respectively:
 - EUR 42.79 million to provide assistance to Austria further to floods that occurred in September 2024, including the amount of EUR 10.66 million as advance payment; and
 - EUR 76.00 million to provide assistance to Poland further to floods that occurred in September 2024;
 - EUR 113.98 million to provide assistance to Czechia further to floods that occurred in September 2024;
 - EUR 2.11 million to provide assistance to Slovakia further to floods that occurred in September 2024;
 - EUR 0.19 million to provide assistance to Moldova further to floods that occurred in September 2024; and
 - EUR 45.67 million to provide assistance to Bosnia and Herzegovina further to floods that occurred in October 2024.
3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal at its meeting on 2 June 2025 and was able to approve it.
4. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to advise the Council to approve the text of the Decision on the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund, as set out in document 9604/25.
