THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) By Decision of 23 September 2024²³, the Council appointed members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on freedom of movement for workers for the period from 25 September 2024 to 24 September 2026.
- (2) A seat as member in the trade union representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Klara BOONSTRA.
- (3) The Netherlands has designated a candidate for the vacant seat,
