<u>Only in case</u> a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority or your organisation's security officer to security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu also by Thursday 14 November 2024 12:00³.

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their PSC certificate has not expired.
