Only in case a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority or your organisation's security officer to [security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu) also **by Thursday 26 June 2025 12:00**<sup>7</sup>.
