Dear **DELETED**,

Thank you for your request for access to documents of the Council of the European Union.¹

You may have access to document **WK 9327/2025 INIT** except to a comment made by a third country. Any unilateral disclosure of this comment would have a negative impact on the relations between the European Union and the said third country.

Disclosure of this part of the document would therefore undermine the protection of the public interest as regards international relations. As a consequence, the General Secretariat is unable to grant a full access to the document.²

The General Secretariat of the Council has examined your request on the basis of the applicable rules: Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145, 31.5.2001, p. 43) and the specific provisions concerning public access to Council documents set out in Annex II to the Council's Rules of Procedure (Council Decision No 2009/937/EU, OJ L 325, 11.12.2009, p. 35).

Article 4(1)(a), third indent, of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.

However, as abovementioned, pursuant to Article 4(6) of the Regulation, you may have access to the rest of the document which is not covered by this exception.

Pursuant to Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you may ask the Council to review this decision within 15 working days of receiving this reply. Should you see the need for such a review, you are invited to indicate the reasons thereof.
