In document ST 15304/24 INIT:

- on page 2, in paragraph 4, “Western Balkan countries” should be replaced by “Western Balkans”. Therefore paragraph 4 should read:
- “4. Within this context, the Presidency proposed draft Council conclusions, with the aim to launch an assessment, in form of a gap analysis, on the need for, the feasibility, and impact of a potential new Europe-wide research and innovation (R&I) initiative on sustainable natural resource management, food systems security and the deployment of the bioeconomy, harnessing the potential of Central and Eastern European Member States, Western Balkans and EU candidate countries. This assessment should be carried out by the Commission and should consider all possible options of a potential new R&I initiative.”

instead of;

“4. Within this context, the Presidency proposed draft Council conclusions, with the aim to launch an assessment, in form of a gap analysis, on the need for, the feasibility, and impact of a potential new Europe-wide research and innovation (R&I) initiative on sustainable natural resource management, food systems security and the deployment of the bioeconomy, harnessing the potential of Central and Eastern European Member States, Western Balkan countries and EU candidate countries. This assessment should be carried out by the Commission and should consider all possible options of a potential new R&I initiative.”
