Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) 2018/1727 as regards the extension of the timeframe for the establishment of the Eurojust case management system (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

- On 2 April 2025 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 85 TFEU, to the 1. Council.
- 2. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered its opinion on 16 April 2025².
- 3. On 10 September 2025 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal³. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u>^{4 5} approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 33/25, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 5. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 of Protocol No 22 on the position of Denmark, annexed to the Treaty on European Union and to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, Denmark is not taking part in the adoption of this Regulation and is not bound by it

or subject to its application.
