Subject: Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on Soil Monitoring and Resilience (Soil Monitoring Law) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

1. On 5 July 2023, the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 192(1) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 25 October 2023².
3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 19 June 2024³.
4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 10 April 2024⁴.

5. The Permanent Representatives Committee confirmed on 21 May 2025 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators on the above Directive⁵, after informal contacts had taken place between the Council and the European Parliament.
 6. On 5 June 2025, the European Parliament's Committee on Environment, Climate and Food Safety (ENVI) confirmed the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators on the above Directive. Subsequently, its Chair sent a letter to the Chair of the Permanent Representatives Committee stating that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic revision) without amendments⁶.
 7. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading, as set out in 9474/25 + COR 1, and the statement of reasons, as set out in 9474/25 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with Germany voting against and Austria abstaining.
 8. The statements for the minutes of the Council are set out in the Addendum to this note.
