d) Detailed grounds for the increase

In 2024 the Centre had a budget deficit of EUR 4.9 million. In the Centre's second amending budget for 2025 to be proposed for adoption to the Management Board on 16 October, the deficit is expected to reach EUR 11.5 million, including the carry-over of the 2024 deficit. This will partially be covered by the Centre's Reserve for pricing stability (EUR 8.1 million), leaving a negative balance of EUR 3.4 million. The requested transfer of EUR 3.4 million from the Commission will allow the Centre to balance the 2025 budget.
