It also took note of the four AOBs requested by the Commission on global climate and energy vision ahead of COP30, on the Efficiency Action Forum 2030, on the state of play of the Tripartite Contract for Affordable Energy and on Commissioner Jørgensen’s annual report on simplification, implementation and enforcement, and decided to take them in public session. The Committee also agreed to invite the Professor of Energy and Climate Policy from Oxford University for the exchange of views on electrification, and the Ukrainian and Moldovan energy ministers for the exchange of views on energy security and resilience.
