## d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

The budgetary provisions related to the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers (EGF) are set in point 9 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 16 December 2020 between the European Parliament, the Council of the European Union and the European Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation in budgetary matters and on sound financial management, as well as on new own resources, including a roadmap towards the introduction of new own resources.

In line with these provisions, the Commission shall present to the European Parliament and the Council a proposal for a transfer of appropriations from the reserve for the EGF to the relevant budgetary line in parallel to the proposal for a decision to mobilise the EGF.

#### d) Detailed grounds for the increase

In the proposal for Decision COM(2025) 621, the Commission concluded, in accordance with all applicable provisions of the EGF Regulation, that the conditions for a financial contribution from the EGF to application EGF/2025/003 SE/Northvolt are met.

The amount of EUR 8 526 322, requested by the Swedish authorities, will contribute to the costs of a coordinated package of eligible personalised services for 5 800 targeted beneficiaries following job displacements in Northvolt (an enterprise operating in the economic sector of architectural and engineering activities, technical testing and analysis) and its subsidiaries, as well as in 8 subcontractors, suppliers, and downstream producers, in line with the intervention criteria set out in Article 4(2), point (a) of the EGF Regulation. The financial contribution from the EGF aims to provide assistance for re-integrating the affected persons into the labour market.
