Only in case a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by the delegate's National Security Authority or other competent national authority or by the sending organisation's security officer to security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu also by **Tuesday, 4 November 2025, cob**, indicating the reference of the meeting in the subject for quicker treatment.

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their PSC certificate has not expired.

Please note that PSC certificates sent by the delegates themselves will not be accepted.
