Appointment of Ms Nicole PINTER, member for Austria, in place of Mr
Johannes PEYRL, who has resigned
- *Adoption*

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Johannes PEYRL, as member of the above Committee in the trade union representatives category (for Austria).
2. Under Articles 23 and 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, Austria has designated Ms Nicole PINTER for this seat for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 24 September 2026.
