1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Elin JANSSON, as member of the above Committee in the government representatives category (for Sweden).
2. Under Articles 23 and 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union<sup>1</sup>, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.
