## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

| Subject: | Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) amending Regulation (EC) No 184/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council, as regards references to the statistical classification of economic activities NACE established by Regulation (EC) No 1893/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council  — Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act |

1. On 2 September 2024, the Commission submitted to the Council a Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) amending Regulation (EC) No 184/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council, as regards references to the statistical classification of economic activities NACE established by Regulation (EC) No 1893/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council (ST 13036/24 + ADD 1), in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 184/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 on Community statistics concerning balance of payments, international trade in services and foreign direct investment.

- 2. The Commission having notified the abovementioned delegated act and its Annex on 2 September 2024, the Council may object to it until 2 December 2024, in accordance with Article 10(6) of Regulation (EC) No 184/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 on Community statistics concerning balance of payments, international trade in services and foreign direct investment.
- 3. During the silence procedure within the Working Party on Statistics, which expired on 30 September 2024, no delegation indicated an intention to object to the delegated act.
- 4. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act, together with its Annex, shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 10(6) of Regulation (EC) No 184/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 on Community statistics concerning balance of payments, international trade in services and foreign direct investment.
