Subject: Attendance of EIGE at the Social Questions Working Party on 13 March 2026

The European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) is preparing a study entitled "From lived reality to policy action: Combatting cyber violence against girls in the EU", which will serve as important background for a set of draft Council Conclusions prepared by the Presidency.

On 13 March 2026, the Presidency intends to organise a meeting of the Social Questions Working Party to discuss the draft Conclusions. The Presidency intends to invite EIGE to present its report at the beginning of this meeting, before the Working Party begins its deliberations.
