THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/127 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 January 2019 establishing the European Foundation for the improvement of living and working conditions (Eurofound), and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 1365/75¹, and in particular Article 4 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) By Decision of 28 March 2023², the Council appointed members and alternate members of the Management Board of the European Foundation for the improvement of living and working conditions for the period from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2027.
- (2) A seat as alternate member in the government representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Lucile CASTEX-CHAUVE.
- (3) The Government of France has designated a candidate for the vacant seat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:
