1. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO ANCHOVY IN THE BAY OF BISCAY

EXPLANATORY NOTE

On 11 December 2024, the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES) published its scientific advice for anchovy (*Engraulis encrasicolus*) in ICES subarea 8 (Bay of Biscay) for 2025<sup>1</sup>.

It is therefore proposed to set the total allowable catches (TAC) for that stock for 2025 in line with that advice, i.e. at the level of 30 663 tonnes (-7% compared to the TAC set for 2024).

## 2. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO ANCHOVY IN THE GULF OF CADIZ

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

On 11 December 2024, ICES published its scientific advice for anchovy in the southern part of ICES division 9a (Gulf of Cadiz and southern coast of Portugal) for 2025<sup>2</sup>.

In addition, as part of the political agreement reached by the Agriculture and Fisheries Council of 9 to 10 December 2024 on the fishing opportunities for 2025, the Council agreed to split the TAC for anchovy in ICES subareas 9 and 10 and EU waters of Fishery Committee for the Eastern Central Atlantic (CECAF) division 34.1.1 into two TACs: (i) a TAC for the northern part of ICES subarea 9 and subarea 10; and (ii) a TAC for the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1. The Council also agreed on allocation keys for those two stocks, which will apply to any new fishing opportunities relating to those stocks established by the Council after 11 December 2024.

Therefore, it is proposed to establish: (i) a TAC for the northern part of ICES subarea 9 and subarea 10 for the period from 1 July 2025 to 30 June 2026, considering that that is the advice period for that stock and considering that Council Regulation (EU) 2024/257<sup>3</sup>, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) 2024/2678<sup>4</sup>, established the fishing opportunities for that stock for the period from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025; and (ii) a TAC for the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1. for 2025. In addition, it is proposed: (i) to provisionally set the TAC for the northern part of ICES subarea 9 and subarea 10 at zero, pending the publication by ICES of its scientific advice; (ii) to set the TAC for the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1. in line with that advice, i.e. at the level of 7 266 tonnes; and (iii) to allocate the TAC for the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1 in line with the allocation key agreed by the Council during the Agriculture and Fisheries Council of 9 to 10 December 2024.

### 3. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO ANCHOVY IN THE NORTHERN PART OF ATLANTIC IBERIAN WATERS

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

On 11 December 2024, ICES published updated scientific advice for anchovy in the northern part of ICES division 9a for the period from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025<sup>5</sup>. ICES increased its catch advice for that stock and that period from 8 480 tonnes to 22 481 tonnes, i.e. by 14 001 tonnes.

In addition, Council Regulation (EU) 2024/257, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) 2024/2678, set a TAC for anchovy in ICES subareas 9 and 10 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1 for the period from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025 in line with: (i) the initial advice for anchovy in the northern part of ICES division 9a and that period; and (ii) the advice for anchovy in the southern part of ICES division 9a for that period<sup>6</sup>.

Moreover, as part of the political agreement reached by the Agriculture and Fisheries Council of 9 to 10 December 2024 on the fishing opportunities for 2025, the Council agreed to split the TAC for anchovy in ICES subareas 9 and 10 and EU waters of Fishery Committee for the Eastern Central Atlantic (CECAF) division 34.1.1 into two TACs: (i) a TAC for the northern part of ICES subarea 9 and subarea 10; and (ii) a TAC for the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1. The Council also agreed on allocation keys for those two stocks, which will apply to any new fishing opportunities relating to those stocks established by the Council after 11 December 2024.

Therefore, it is proposed to amend Council Regulation (EU) 2024/257 and: (i) to increase the TAC for anchovy in ICES subareas 9 and 10 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1 for the period from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025 in line with the updated advice for anchovy in the northern part of ICES division 9a for that period, i.e. by 14 001 tonnes; and (ii) to allocate the increase in the TAC in line with the allocation key agreed by the Council during the Agriculture and Fisheries Council of 9 to 10 December 2024.

Moreover, in the interest of legal certainty, it is proposed to clarify that, in the period from 1 January 2025 to 30 June 2025, Member States' quotas under the TAC for anchovy in ICES subareas 9 and 10 and EU waters of CECAF division 34.1.1 may only be fished in the northern part of subarea 9 and subarea 10, given that it is proposed to set a TAC for anchovy in the southern part of ICES subarea 9 and EU waters of CECF 34.1.1 for 2025.
