Subject: Attendance of third parties at the Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth (Internal Market) on 5 May 2026
- Approval

1. The Presidency would like to invite the representatives of the European Court of Auditors, the European Economic and Social Committee and of the European Committee of the Regions, to the meeting of the Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth (Internal Market) scheduled on 5 May 2026.
2. The purpose of the attendance of the above-mentioned third parties is to present their respective opinions¹ on the proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the Single Market and Customs Programme for the period 2028-2034, repealing Regulations (EU) 2021/444, (EU) 2021/690, (EU) 2021/785, (EU) 2021/847 and (EU) 2021/1077.
3. In addition, the European Committee of the Regions would also be invited to present its opinion² on the Single Market Strategy.
