Subject: Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers following an application from Belgium (EGF/2025/009 BE/Soliver)

1. On 30 April 2026, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 07/2026<sup>1</sup>.
2. The proposal aims to mobilise an amount of EUR 2.13 million under the EGF to meet an application from Belgium to deploy the Fund to provide assistance for reintegrating 803 targeted beneficiaries into the labour market following workers' displacements in Soliver N.V. in Belgium (a manufacturer of high-tech automotive glass), in line with the intervention criteria set out in point (a) of Article 4(2) of Regulation (EU) 2021/691<sup>2</sup>.
