Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the screening of foreign investments in the Union and repealing Regulation (EU) 2019/452 (**first reading**)
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 24 January 2024 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Articles 114 and 207 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 11 July 2024².
3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 20 November 2024³.
4. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered its opinion on 15 March 2024⁴.

5. On 19 May 2026 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal⁵. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to:
 - confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 10/26, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting;
 - decide to publish the statement set out in Addendum 1 in the C series of the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
7. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum 1 to this note.
8. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
