**Outcomes of the D9+ Ministerial Meeting**

**(Luxembourg, 8 June 2026)**

The purpose of this addition under “Any other business” is to provide ministers of the TTE Council (Telecommunications) with the main outcomes of the D9+ Ministerial meeting held in Luxembourg on 8 June 2026. Ministers from the D9+ countries<sup>1</sup> met the day before the TTE Council to informally discuss priority matters in the field of digital policy with a view to contribute constructively and proactively to the EU-level public policy development. As a result, this year’s edition included discussions on European competitiveness and the protection of minors online.

<sup>1</sup> *The D9+ is an informal group of member states consisting of the 13 most digitally advanced countries of the EU, namely Sweden, Finland, Denmark, Belgium, the Netherlands, Spain, Portugal, Poland, Czechia, Slovenia, Estonia, Ireland and Luxembourg. The European Commission and the rotating presidency of the Council of the EU are associated to the D9+ ministerial meetings.*

Regarding the debate on European competitiveness, D9+ ministers mainly focused on challenges and ambitions relating to digital sovereignty in an open manner. In addition, the discussion evolved around the long-term priorities for the simplification agenda.

Concerning the protection of minors online, D9+ ministers discussed measures to provide a safe and age-appropriate online environment for minors online.
