Subject: Contribution on the employment and social policies aspects of the country-specific recommendations: Recommendations on the economic, social, employment, structural and budgetary policies of each Member State
- *Approval*

In the context of the 2026 European Semester process, the Commission submitted the proposals for country-specific recommendations (CSRs) as set out in doc. 9955/26 to the Council on 3 June 2026.

The 27 documents (one for each Member State) were examined by the EMCO and SPC Committees. Due to time constraints following the submission of the spring package by the Commission, a horizontal note on the country-specific recommendations was drawn up and discussed in the relevant Committees (EMCO, SPC, EPC, EFC-A, EFC). The European Council discussed the integrated country-specific recommendations on the basis of a horizontal note, thus allowing the conclusion of the 2026 European Semester at its meeting on 18-19 June. The aspects in the individual CSRs pertaining uniquely to the ECOFIN *filière* will be discussed after the ECOFIN Council on 12 June. The versions of the CSRs listed in document 10247/26 are therefore not the final versions

The list of draft Recommendations for each Member State, as resulting from the EMCO, SPC and EPC discussions, is set out in doc. 10247/26.

Coreper is invited to examine the draft recommendations for each Member State listed in doc. 10247/26, with a view to enabling the Council (EPSCO) to approve its contribution on employment and social policy -related aspects of the draft Council recommendations for each Member State and the aspects pertaining to both the EPSCO and the ECOFIN *filières*.

The Council will adopt the integrated country-specific recommendations at the Council (ECOFIN) meeting on 10 July 2026.
