	The appointment of Ms Sarah JUDGE, alternate member for Ireland, in place of Ms Dearbháil NIC GIOLLA MHICÍL, who has resigned

- 1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Dearbháil NIC GIOLLA MHICÍL as alternate member of the above Committee in the government representatives category (for Ireland).
- 2. Under Article 75 of Regulation (EC) 883/2004 of 29 April 2004¹ which sets up the Advisory Committee for the Coordination of Social Security Systems, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council, whereas by the Council Decision of 21 September 2020², the appointments are valid for a period of five years.

 - (a) <u>adopt</u>, as an "A" item, <u>the Council Decision</u> replacing an alternate member of the Advisory Committee for the Coordination of Social Security Systems, as set out in doc. 5330/25, and
 - (b) have the Decision <u>published</u>, for information, in the Official Journal of the European Union.
