### **Introduction** Act CXXX of 2010 on law-making

6. Obligation to give reasons

Section 18

(1) Those preparing a law shall attach a statement of reasons to the draft law to <u>describe the social</u>, <u>economic</u>, <u>professional</u> <u>reasons and aims underpinning the need to regulate</u>, as well as to present the <u>expected effects of legal regulation</u> and their position on disclosing the statement of reasons.



### **Introduction** The Fundamental Law of Hungary

Article 28

In the course of the application of law, <u>courts shall interpret the</u> <u>text of laws primarily in accordance with their purpose</u> and with the Fundamental Law.

In the course of ascertaining the purpose of a law, consideration shall be given primarily to the preamble of that law and <u>the</u> justification of the proposal for, or for amending, the law. [...]


Case study: Act CXXV of 2018 on Government Administration

Section 259 [Salary of the Head of the Office]

The salary of the head of the office shall be set by the Minister designated by government decree for the management of the government office on the proposal of the Government Commissioner – taking into account the characteristics of the district or district office concerned, in particular the population of the district, the organisation, tasks and staff of the district office –, at a maximum of twenty-two times the salary base. "Explanatory" note to Section 259


# Measuring the extent of "copy-paste" – text reuse

Testing multiple measurement approaches


Based on preliminary data: The rate of "copy and paste" shows an increasing trend

Average similarity – standardised (Z-Score)






## Measuring the extent of "copy-paste" – text reuse
